- Maintain a comprehensive understanding of operating instructions of each inflatable and ensure correct operation by staff and patrons at all times
- o Promote a positive safety culture, identifying potential risks to and take steps to reduce those risks
- Ensure the facility is clean and presentable at all times by performing general cleaning and basic maintenance
- o Setup, pack down and delivery of Birthday Parties
- o Follow manual handling procedures for setup and pack up of equipment
- o Provide a safe and enjoyable environment for customers, proactively engaging with customers
- Communicate effectively with staff, participants, and parents to ensure high engagement, timely feedback, issue resolution, and the sharing of relevant information
